To encourage **diversity in urban and regional planning**, the Virginia Tech Master of Urban and Regional Planning Program (MURP) is launching a **Community Scholars Fellowship Program** in **Fall 2021** to financially support selected incoming **MURPs from underrepresented groups** (including African American, Latinx, Pacific Islander, or American Indian) based on academic achievement and promise within the field.

Besides the **\$4000 financial award**, the recipient will be paired with a **faculty and/or professional mentor(s)**, who will help guide their **graduate study and professional development** during their time in the program, as well as offer support navigating a profession which remains majority-white.
