Departmental Policies

<u>Hours Requirement</u>: A total of 120 hours is required to graduate with a PUA degree. Fifty-four (54) credit hours are required to complete the Environmental Policy and Planning major (Section II + Section III).

<u>In-major GPA</u>: All of the courses in sections II and III are included in the in-major GPA calculation. A GPA of 2.0 or above (overall and in-major) is required for graduation.

<u>Satisfactory Progress</u>: To make satisfactory progress within the EPP major, students must complete UAP 1024, PSCI 1014, SPIA 2114, STAT 3604, and UAP 3354 by the end of the semester in which 60 hours have been attempted; and maintain an in-major GPA of 2.0.

<u>Dual Use of Courses</u>: No course can double count within or between SPIA-related majors or minors with the exception of the Core Degree Requirements (Section II below). In accordance with university guidelines, courses satisfying degree core requirements may not be used to satisfy other areas of a degree (e.g. Pathways).

<u>Intra-SPIA Program majoring and minoring</u>: Students may pursue more than one major or minor associated with the School of Public and International Affairs Program. In this case, the policy pertaining to the "Dual Use of Courses" will apply.

<u>Prerequisites</u>: Some courses listed on this checksheet have prerequisites. Be sure to consult the University Catalog and/or check with your advisor regarding course planning.
